

## Directions On How To Register with USA Rugby

- 1.) Go to [www.usarugby.org](http://www.usarugby.org)
- 2.) Once on the USA Rugby homepage, click on 'Membership' at the top of the left hand column of links.
- 3.) Once the Membership page appears in the main information field to the right, click on 'Register', underneath the 'Membership Quick Links' banner.
- 4.) The next page will ask you to 'Choose your membership options', so click on 'Create/Renew Individual Membership' which is at the top of the list of options.
- 5.) Fill out the blank fields on the next page, select whether you are a returning or new member, and click on 'continue'.
- 6.) If you are a returning member, the next page will give you a list of potential matching records; select one to continue.
- 7.) The next page is a medical insurance agreement, so scroll to the bottom, check each question to accept it, and then click on the 'accept' button.
- 8.) Fill out the blank fields on the next page but do not click on the 'National Guard Partnership' request at the bottom, then click on 'continue'.
- 9.) The next page will ask you for your role, level, and club. You need to select 'Player' for the first blank, and then 'HS (U 19)' for the second blank. For the third blank type in 'Jupiter Rugby', and the club name will appear, which you have to click on to select. After that hit 'Save', then hit 'Check Out'.
- 10.) It will cost \$20 to register as a High School age-grade participant.
- 11.) Next an Order Summary page will appear, upon which you have to complete your order by filling out your Payment Details and Billing Address.
- 12.) After you complete your order, print your confirmation page, which will have your new USA Rugby CIPP Registration number on it. You should also get a receipt emailed to you, which you can print if you forget to print your confirmation page. Turn in one of these pages with your other JTAA Rugby documents.

### Important Notice:

All players coming to try-outs or practice, new or returning players, must be registered with USA Rugby BEFORE they step onto the field. You must bring your USA Rugby CIPP registration confirmation page or receipt, with your CIPP number clearly shown on it, to your first try-out /practice session. If you do not have this, you will not be allowed to participate!

Registering with USA Rugby covers each individual with a 1 million dollar liability insurance plan. It is the same requirement that high school sports have prior to try-outs, when you pay a minimal fee for insurance coverage to get you through the try-out period. The USA Rugby coverage is \$10 more, but will cover you beyond the try-out period and cover you for an entire year of playing rugby if you make the team. Meanwhile, for high school sports the try-out fee of \$10 does not extend beyond the try-out period, and an additional \$50 is required to cover you for the year if you make the team. The 20\$ registration fee for USA Rugby DOES NOT go to Jupiter Rugby, whether you make the team or not. If you do not make the team, you DO NOT get a refund of that registration fee.
